Organization Structure

Establishing a Training Program

Establishing a program is easy.

Suggested steps:

- 1. Identify the necessary resources
- 2. Train a Powerboat Instructor
- 3. Develop a program plan and budget
- 4. Run courses





Identifying Resources

• **Powerboats:** 16'-26' w/adequate hp to plane w/2-3 adults onboard. 2 or 3 boats is recommended.

Marks with ground tackle for drills



Training Instructors

 Having a Certified Powerboat Instructor on staff eliminates the need contract an instructor for a course. Saves you money and gives you flexibility.

 Powerboat Instructor Course: 3-day course for advanced powerboat operators.



Training Instructors

Powerboat Instructor Course: \$350

An intensive 3-day course for advanced powerboat operators, instructor candidates will learn the fundamentals of on-the-water instruction. Candidates must successfully demonstrate superior presentation, teaching and powerboat operation skills in order to complete this course.
